

FRAMEWORK OF REFERENCE BUDGETS




REFERENCE BUDGETS TO FULLY PARTICIPATE IN SOCIETY



Monthly amounts May 2022, Flanders, Brussels, Wallonia.

A reference budget represent the minimum required by households to fully participate in society. Here, budgets are illustrated for households with non-working adults or for one or two pensioners. Family members are in good health, have the necessary skills to manage their budget sustainably, live in a qualitative dwelling and do not own a car. The youngest child is a toddler, the oldest or only child is between 6 and 12 years old.



- Up till 2023: 44 PCSWs
- Royal Decree (22/01/2023):
 - 424 PCSWs
 - Subsidies for PCSWs
 - Budget: 2 x 35 million euros

- Implemented REDI tool as a basic diagnosis-tool in team debt mediation to determine feasibility
