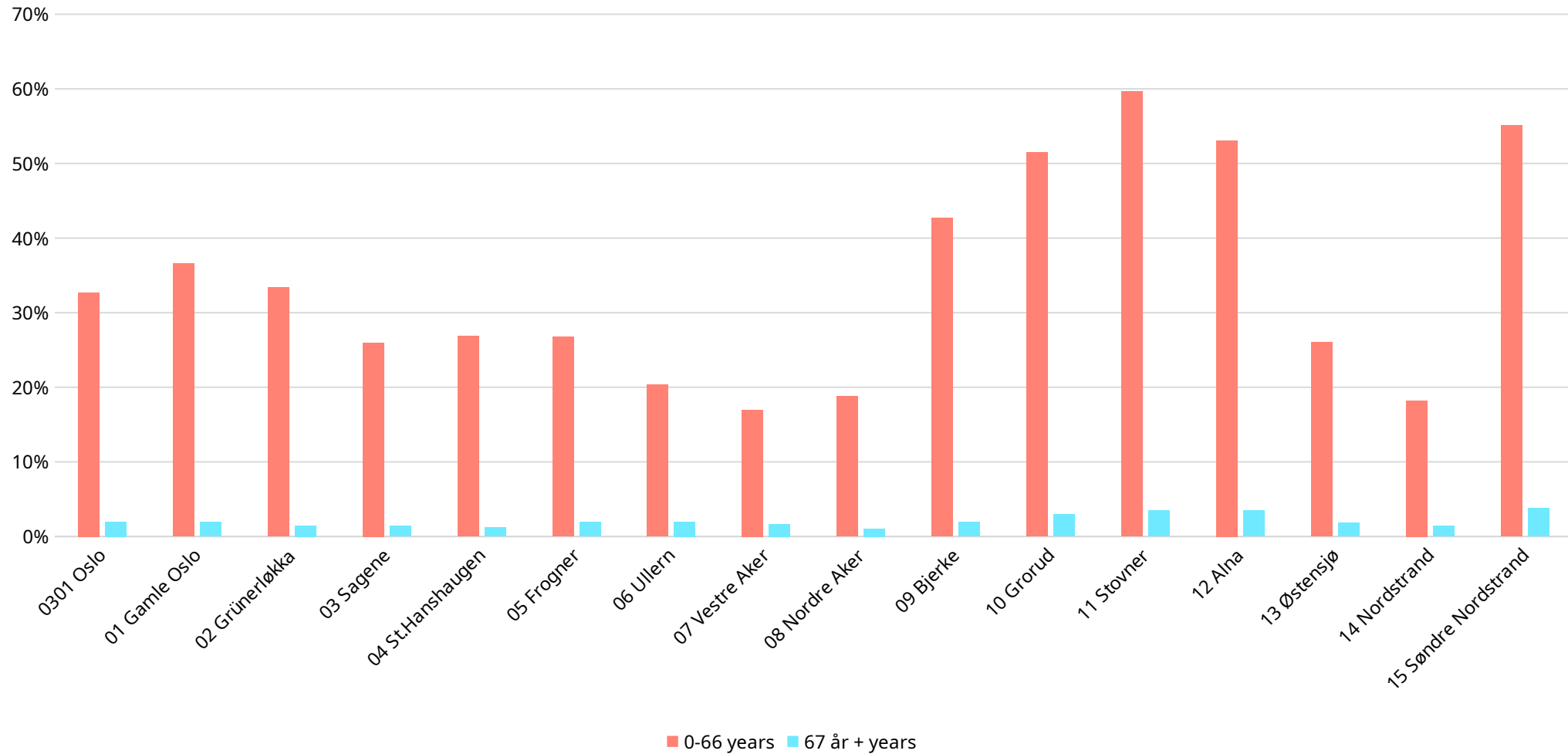

Capital of Norway

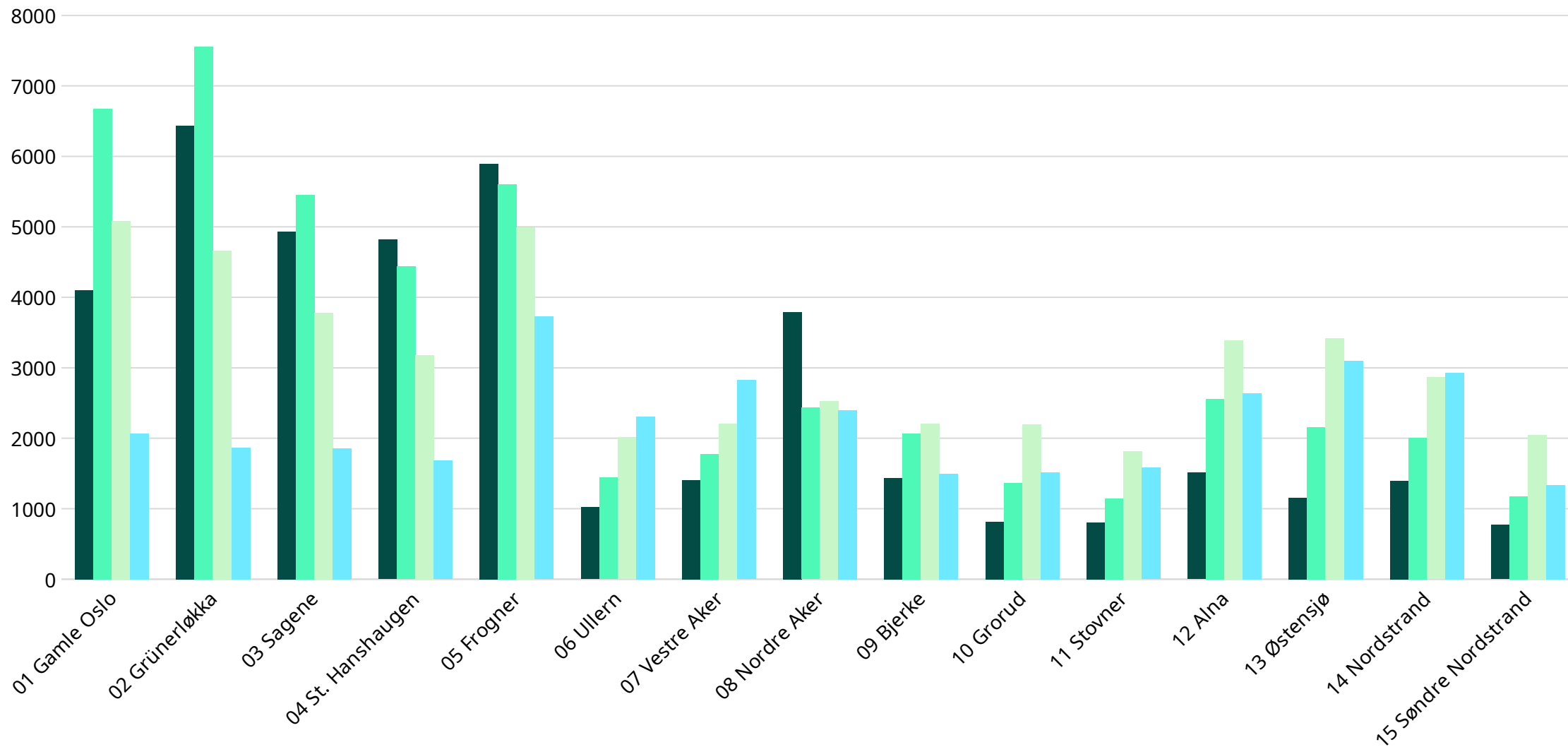
- ▶ Inhabitants 2024: 717 710
- ▶ 15 Districts
- ▶ Approx 83.000 age > 67 years
- ▶ Approx 23.000 age > 80 years

Ruter Age-friendly transport - RAT

- ▶ Door-to-door transport
- ▶ Customers 67 years and up

- ▶ Oldest customer: 102 years

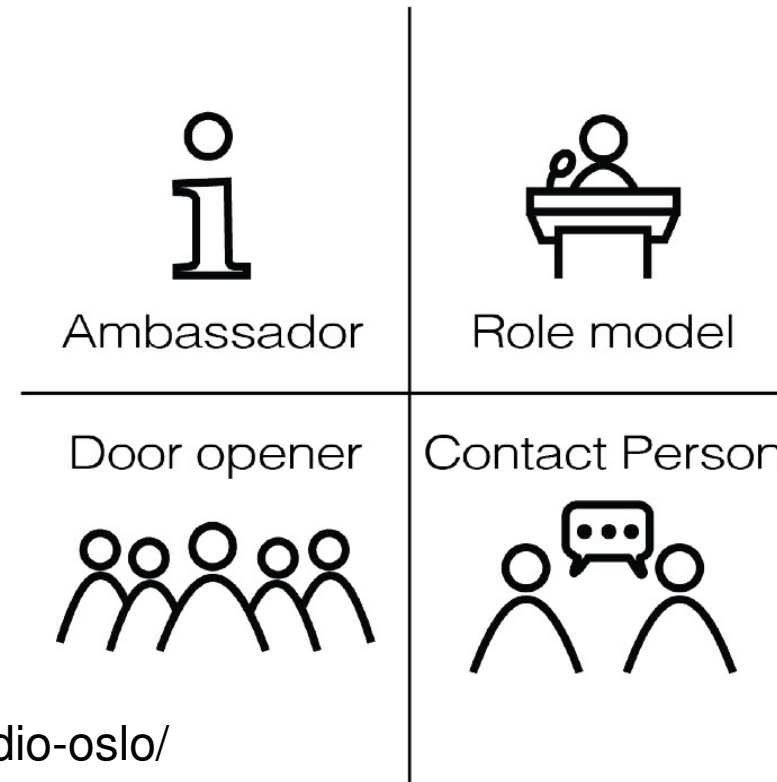

Successfactors - Alna district

- ▶ Don't generalize
- ▶ Find «door openers» – “word of mouth”
- ▶ Be present - where they are, you are
- ▶ Be open and build trust
- ▶ Collaboration with citizens, volunteers, relatives, employees, organizations
- ▶ Find arenas for community and activity, regardless of language
- ▶ Information in several languages
- ▶ Find what unites us
