








Ontario's employment services are transforming alongside social assistance and disability support services in the Province, bringing a multitude of changes to the supported workforce development sector.





Ontario's Transformation in the Integrated Employment Services Model

| 3 Major Changes | Current Model | |
|---|---|--|
| Integration of Social Assistance and Disability Supports into Employment Services to remove government oversight silos | 3 avenues for employment supports through Ontario Works (OW), Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) and Employment Ontario (EO) | |
| Locally responsive management through SSMs | Oversight and management of service contracts from the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development directly to organizations delivering OW, ODSP and EO. SSM management non-existant | |
| Performance-based incentives to promote retention & accountability | Funding based on Client Volume with some inclusion of performance. | |



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New Model

Employment supports delivered through 1 pathway under Employment Ontario

Government will adjust oversight and management of service contracts from the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development to Service System Managers (SSMs) in 15 catchment areas

20% of funding based on Performance, measured by Retention-Based employment outcomes.

- Fostering a culture of innovation so people can adapt, feel comfortable with change and prevent burnout from continual change









Navigating Personalized Career Pathways

Example of hybrid service delivery model between technology platforms and community service providers:


- Launched a platform catered to the vulnerable jobseekers we serve
- Integrated with First Work programs for unified network experience
- Enhanced referral workflows to match jobseekers with regional service providers
- Outreach to >4000 contacts from higher ed, school boards, and community organizations
- Registered over 12,000 users to the platform
- Over 1400 users are employed
